Round Robin System Progression

Buenos Aires 2018 Youth Olympic Games

Each weight Kumite category will have 8 athletes per discipline, distributed in 2 pools of 4 athletes each.

1 gold, 1 silver and 2 bronze medals will be awarded as corresponds.

Elimination rounds

6 bouts on each pool

Semi-finals

2 bouts

Semi-final 1: 1st Pool A v 2nd Pool B

Semi-final 2: 1st Pool B v 2nd Pool A

Medal bouts

1 bout

Gold Medal Match: Winner Semi-final 1 v Winner Semi-final 2

Points for each bout

KUMITE WEIGHT CATEGORIES

- 2 points will be awarded to a competitor winning a bout
- 1 point will be awarded to a competitor in case of tied bout
- 0 points will be awarded to a competitor losing a bout

Tie breaks

In cases where there is a tie between 2 or more competitors, having the same number of total points, the criteria below will be applied in the specified order. This means, if a winner is found after one of the criteria, the following criteria will not have to be applied

1. Winner(s) of the bout(s) between the 2 or more relevant competitors
2. Higher number of total scores obtained in favour through all bouts
3. Lower number of total scores got against through all bouts
4. Higher number of Ippons in favour
5. Lower number of Ippons against
6. Higher number of Waza-Aris in favour
7. Lower number of Waza-Aris against
8. Higher number of Yukos in favour
9. Lower number of Yukos against
10. Highest position in the Olympic Standing as of 01.06.2018
