### Olympic Solidarity - World Programmes

The world programmes provide the NOCs with access to technical, financial and administrative assistance for organising specific activities linked to the development of sport.

For the 2017-2020 quadrennial plan, Olympic Solidarity is offering 21 world programmes. These programmes are fully in-keeping with the previous plan, even though some of them have been slightly modified or even combined. Their main aim is to increase global assistance to the athletes, to optimise the management of NOCs and to simplify administrative procedures, in order to adapt to the NOCs' requirements and needs.

These are divided into five areas for the organisation of specific activities related to the development of the sport:

- Athletes
- Coaches
- NOC Management & Knowledge Sharing
- Promotion of the Olympic Values
- Forums & Special Projects

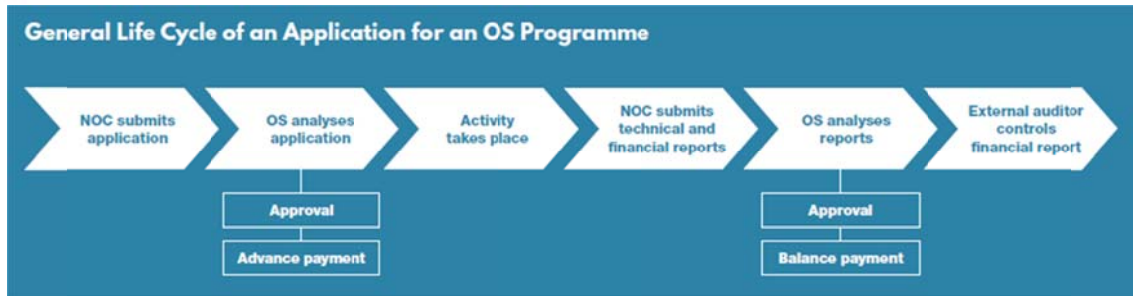

All the NOCs will have access to the world programmes during the 2017-2020 quadrennial period. However, in line with Olympic Solidarity's mission, the budget allocations granted in the framework of these programmes will be provided to the NOCs which have the greatest need, as a priority.
