



***SPORTS COMMISSION RULES
(SCR)***



SPORTS COMMISSION (SC)

1. The purpose of the Sports Commission is to consolidate proposals from the respective Commissions before their presentation to the WKF Executive Committee.
2. The Sports Commission will be composed of the respective Chairmen of the Referee Commission, the Technical Commission, the Medical Commission and the Athletes Commission plus 1 member of the TC and 1 member of the RC appointed by the respective Chairman. In the event that a member of the Commission is unable to attend a meeting he must delegate in another member of the relevant Commission to act on his behalf. The exception is the SC Chairman who must attend the meeting in order that the Sports Commission may assemble.
3. The Chairman of the Sports Commission may in principle be rotated between the Chairmen of the TC & RC. The Chairman will be rotated at the discretion of the Executive Committee.
4. In addition to the three members of the Sports Commission the Executive Committee may appoint a Sports Commissioner to co-ordinate the communication with the Executive Committee and to assist the Sports Commission in practical matters related to their work.
5. All propositions originated by the respective WKF TC, RC, and MC shall be subjected to the scrutiny of the Sports Commission prior to its presentation to the Executive Committee. In the event that the Sports Commission is unable to formulate a joint proposal, the Sports Commissioner, or the WKF President if there is no Sports Commissioner, will ensure that the objections to the proposal, raised by any dissenting member of the Commission, are duly recorded in an amendment to the proposal before it is presented to the Executive Committee.
6. Any member of the Sports Commission will have the right to directly present a proposal to the Executive Committee provided that the other members of the Commission are given the opportunity to debate the issues and make amendments before the proposal is put forward to the Executive Committee.
7. All meetings are called by the Chairman of the Commission. The Chairman will present any proposal to the EC in person. In the event of any dissent to a proposal presented, it remains the duty of the Sports Commissioner, or of the WKF President, to present the amendment to the proposal recording the objections presented in the Sports Commission.
